INTERACTIVE / HANDS-ON EXPERIENCES

- **Tour & Taster**
Students complete a short curriculum and/or college tour, followed by a guided task.
- **Class Shadowing**
Working alongside current students, shadowing and experiencing a typical morning/afternoon.
- **A Day in the Life Rotation**
Carousel across 3–4 curriculum areas in one visit (1 hour each) to help undecided learners explore options.
- **Skills Olympics / Competition**
Fun, quick challenges (timed tasks, teamwork, creativity) with prizes; lots of fun engagement.
- **Problem-Solving Challenge**
Subject-based with clues linked to real course content.
- **Live Demonstrations**
Lecturers + students demonstrate high-level work (e.g. hair styling, welding, cooking).
- **Hands-on models**
Being models for the curriculum (dependent on subject, would work well with Hair & Beauty).
- **Portfolio/Work-in-Progress Viewing**
See real student work with tutor explanation of grading and progression.

INSIGHT & CAREER-FOCUSED

- **Career Pathway Talk & Activity**
"How do you get into this career?" followed by a practical taster linked to that career.
- **Apprenticeship Insight Session**
Delivered by tutors and potentially current apprentices.

STUDENT EXPERIENCE FOCUS

- **Student Takeover Tour**
Led fully by current students.
- **Speed dating**
Networking activity with current students studying the course they're interested in.
- **Q&A Panel with Current Students**
Honest conversations about workload, social life, progression.

CAMPUS & FACILITIES-FOCUSED

- **Sports Session / Fitness Challenge:** Practical activity using Institute of Sport.
- **Digital/VR Experience:** Use any immersive tech (construction sims, health sims).
- **Competition Launches:** Start in-school, finish on campus e.g. Design challenge, Bake-off, Build challenge, fitness. Finals take place on campus, in our industry-standard facilities.

SCHOOL SITE

- **Curriculum Pop-In Tasters**
Deliver mini versions of practical sessions in classrooms e.g. Hair styling demo, Engineering problem-solving, Creative Digital Media challenges.
- **Career Carousel Sessions**
Rotate between small groups across different subject stations, focusing on what careers each course could take you to.
- **Enrichment Days**
Half-day / set number of hours takeover with themed sessions.
